Mission Statement

High Tech High Chula Vista students from team 20/20 Vision who take pride hands on learning experiences to understand the world around us. We plan using eco-friendly materials, that won't affect the environment around us in building this community.

Overview and Goals

We are designing a temporary stage for Space 4 Art's Permanent housing project. The stage is designed to be easily moved. It will be constructed so that the audience has an unobstructed view of the performers. The roof will have support beams and where stage lighting will be bolted. The roof will be ¼ inches thick: 8 foot panels that will allow easy assembly. The portable stage will be made into 4' x 8' panels which will be the platform and 8'x8' panels. The temporary stage will be used by artists to perform and display their art.

The stage will be used to bring the community together. In revenue we want people to perform on stage. By doing so, it can bring people to see the performances. The temporary stage can also be used as a space to meet up.

In addition, the stage can be used to showcase art. The artist can hang up pieces of art on the wall. The stage can also have art on the beams in the front. The beams will give support to the stage by... The art can also be projected on the back wall to save space during auctions and events.

The Temporary Stage will be rented out so we can earn money to replace damaged parts of the stage and replace them. Space 4 Art will be able to bring in more revenue by renting the space to community members. This can be a model to other communities about the impact of communal living.

Our plans for maintaining will be dependent on how the Temporary stage will be stored. We will have a more detailed protocol once we find this information.

Funding section

We, 20/20 Vision will be having a fundraiser on January 21, 2017 at Space 4 Art that will include silent auctions, raffling items, entertainment, and games. We will be selling tickets for \$20 and \$50 for people outside of the High Tech High community.

We will also be applying for Karma for Cara Foundation which is a micro-grant ranging from \$250-\$1,000. This grant may help pay for building supplies for the eco-village project. The Permanent Housing project is designed to use local areas in neighborhoods. We will be building a portable temporary stage that will be used for artists to perform or display their art. This stage would allow a platform for the artists in a designated area where an audience can gather. The building of the eco-village with a garden and stage that will help build and reestablish our community. The money will be used directly for this project. Once the eco-village is completed

In order to raise more money other than the fundraiser we are having on January 21, 2017. We would want to have a fundraiser at Nuyo yogurt or Jersey Mikes that can give us money from the food purchased. Also showing a movie at High Tech High can bring money by letting us sell snacks to the people that come. There can also be a time where we can just sell things we don't need These fundraiser ideas can lead to 20/20 vision to get at least more than \$100.

Physical Planning

The Temporary Stage will be located on the ground floor at the south end in the Permanent Housing project.
